Attendance / Checking In or Out

LPS requires parents/guardians to notify their student's school when their student will be absent. You may report a **full day absence** in one of two ways:

- You may **call the Frost main line and follow the prompts** for the attendance line, or to request homework on the third day absent.
- Use the [Student Absence Form](#) found on the Frost website found under "Quick Links", or from the drop down menu on the Parents Tab.

Please do not use the form for tardy students. Tardy students should bring a parent note to the main office when they enter the building to be excused. Parents do not need to come in and sign their student into school.

Students leaving early should bring a **parent note to the main office before school** and a pass will be issued before school starts... your child will be released at your requested time *without interruption to the classroom*. The student will sign out in the main office and exit to their parent's vehicle waiting in front of the main office doors.
